



# INDEXFINGER

IndexFinger simplifies the task of creating a web site index - one page which links to every page on your website. IndexFinger is for webmasters with access to a website residing on their hard drive. IndexFinger is not for indexing websites on the web, you must have a folder containing your website on your computer for IndexFinger to function properly.

**Step 1:** Select the folder containing your website. Do this by clicking the "Select Folder" button at the top of the IndexFinger interface. A file selection dialogue box will appear. Find the folder containing your website, select the folder, then click the "choose" button in the bottom right corner of the dialogue box.

**Step 2:** Set the various preferences for how you want your index to appear.

Step 3: Edit which files you want to appear in your index. To exclude a file or folder from the index, select it in the file panel, then hit "delete" on your keyboard or the "Take file(s) off list" button.

**Step 4:** Click the "Build" button.

Now where is the file? It is in the folder you selected with the name you chose for "Site Index File Name."

This is a demo version of IndexFinger. This demo limits the number of links generated per site index to 19. After 19 links have been made, IndexFinger will list the other files in the website, but not make them hyperlinks.
